
## **Storytime Ideas**



**Book Title:** About Bats/Acerca de los murcielagos

About the Book: Take flight and learn about the only mammal that can fly. After reading this book you will have a newfound understanding of bats.

## **Storytime Activities:**

Dress Up Fun!	Dress up with a cape or shawl. Flap your arms as if your bat taking flight.
What's in the Mystery Bag?	Use your mystery bag to pull out pictures of different animals, insects, objects. (Ask, "Do bats eat frogs?")
Whiteboard Activities:	As you read, draw or write information about bat on the whiteboard. Start with drawing a bat. Add pictures of new information that you find out, such as what they eat, where they sleep, etc.
Actions & Transitions:	<ul> <li>Before Reading, ask:</li> <li>What do you know about bats?</li> <li>Where do bats live?</li> <li>Let's take a picture walk to see what information we can find out about bats.</li> <li>After Reading, ask:</li> <li>What are three amazing facts about bats?</li> <li>Where, how, and when do bats sleep?</li> </ul>
	Movement: Invite children to flap their arms and move like a bat.
