## Book Title: How Many?/¿Cuántos hay?

**About the Book:** *How Many?/ ¿*Cuántos hay? Offers an opportunity for children to practice counting and identifying the numbers from 1 to 10. Throughout the book, questions invite the reader to count the number of certain items in each picture. As they develop their skills through this book, children will become better prepared for both reading and mathematics.

## **Storytime Activities:**

Dress Up Fun!	Use your imagination to dress for an adventure!
What's in the Mystery Bag?	Use your mystery bag to pull out different numbers from the bag. How many numbers do you have in the bag?
Whiteboard Activities:	To help children become familiar with numbers, use the whiteboard to write "how many" on each page. Use numbers, tally marks or other ways to show how many!
Actions & Transitions:	Play "I Spy" where you take turns seeing things in the room, say its name and remember it. Start with one item, say the item name and invite children to say the name. Add another item and repeat. Try to play up to five items.
